**Faculty Positions in Biochemistry and Organic Chemistry**

The Chemistry Department at the University of Central Florida invites applications for two tenure-track faculty positions (**Biochemistry** and **Organic Chemistry**) to begin in Fall 2008, rank is open. A Ph.D. in Chemistry, or closely related field, is required, and postdoctoral experience is preferred. Candidates at the higher ranks must have a demonstrated record of accomplishment in extramural funding, publication, and teaching. In addition to contributing to teaching at both the graduate and undergraduate levels, the successful candidates are expected to develop externally-funded, nationally-recognized research programs. There are numerous opportunities for campus-wide interactions with researchers in other UCF colleges and research centers. The University of Central Florida is located in Orlando, Florida, has become one of the nation's largest universities with 48,000 students, and is continuing to build nationally-recognized research programs.
