Undergraduate Tuition and Fees

- A Flat rate for 12 to 17 hours.
- B Excludes campus dining fee.
- C Beginning in 2004-05, college-specific course fees were required of all undergraduate and graduate students.
- D Beginning with undergraduate students enrolling Fall 2006, University System schools are offering guaranteed tuition for a defined period of time. The rate provided for undergraduates reflect the guaranteed rate.
- E The 2005-06 required fees have been adjusted from the prior published amounts because additional required fees previously adopted for multi-year phase-in now meet the definition for inclusion in average undergraduate fees.
- F Totals include tuition and mandatory fees and assume 30 hours per year for undergraduate students.
- G Undergraduate fees include a \$67 transit fee charged to all full-time students but do not include a \$100 library fee charged to students with 30 or more credit hours. Business majors at the junior/senior level pay a major fee of \$800 per semester. Non-Business majors pay a \$65 per credit hour fee to take Business courses at the 300/400 level.
- H All undergraduates are charged a flat rate tuition based on the college in which they are enrolled. The flat rate covers academic program costs including tuition, mandatory fees and charges, and college and course fees not previously included when reporting tuition and mandatory fees. All undergraduate students taking 12 or more credit hours are charged the same flat rate tuition amount for their college. For reporting purposes, the Liberal Arts flat rate tuition is used as the general undergraduate rate. Graduate Tuition and Fees

- A Flat rate for 9 to 15 hours.
- B Beginning in 2004-05, college-specific course fees were required of all undergraduate and graduate students.
- C Based on 24 credits per year.
- D Totals include tuition and mandatory fees and assume 24 hours per year for graduate students.
- E Beginning in Fall 2007, there are four tiers of graduate tuition. In addition, graduate tuition includes all fees. The rate shown is for Tier 2 (rates decrease going from Tier 1 to Tier 4). Each tier's tuition is set to be a realistic market rate based on peer programs at other institutions identified by each department. The on-campus MBA program is charged at the Tier 2 level.
- G Graduate tuition and fees are based on 18 semester credit hours per academic year (Tuition and fees for previous academic years were based on 24 semester credit hours.). For reporting purposes, and to complement the undergraduate reporting rate, the Liberal Arts tuition and fee rate is used as the general graduate rate (graduate rates for other colleges can be found at http://www.utexas.edu/business/accounting/sar/t_f_rates.html). MBA tuition and fees are based on 24 semester credit hours per academic year. Only required fees charged to all graduate students are included; college and course fees such as advising, placement and specific courses fees which vary by college and program are not included.

Law Tuition and Fees

- A** Law rates are for new students.
- B** Law tuition is based on 30 semester hours.
- C** Law tuition and fees are based on 28 semester credit hours per academic year. Only required fees charged to all graduate students are included; incidental fees such as advising, placement, and course-related lab fees which vary by college and program are not included.
