### LGBT Life with Full Text

**Coverage:** 1967-present

**Description:** Provides abstracts and citations to Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender literature published worldwide. Citations represent periodical articles, books, newspapers, newsletters, case studies, speeches, and other formats. The National Information Services Corporation's Sexual Diversity Studies and One National Gay & Lesbian Archives contributed information held in LGBT Life. Lesbian Herstory Archives of the Lesbian Herstory Educational Foundation will assist with further development of the database. Depth of coverage varies by source. Also, includes full text for 50 LGBT journals, magazines and regional newspapers, as well as dozens of full text books.

**Coverage:** 1970-present

**Description:** GenderWatch is a full-text database of publications that focus on the impact of gender across a broad spectrum of subject areas. The database provides in-depth coverage of the subjects that are uniquely central to women's lives, including family, childbirth, birth control, daycare, domestic abuse, work and the workplace, sexual harassment, aging, aging parents, body image, eating disorders and social and societal roles.
