It is requested, but not required, that a letter of intent be submitted to the scholarship committee before the application deadline. All application packets should be submitted to the Capstone Alliance Scholarship Committee and be postmarked by December 17th, 2011.

REQUIREMENTS:

Applicant must be a full-time student in good academic standing with a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale; recipient must demonstrate an outstanding commitment to and support for the gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, and queer student population on the University of Alabama campus; recipient may be an undergraduate or graduate student. Please attach an unofficial copy of your transcript.

LETTER OF INTENT:

It is encouraged that each applicant submit a brief, informal letter stating their intention to apply for the scholarship. This letter can be in the form of an email sent to capstonealliance@gmail.com.

ESSAY INSTRUCTIONS:

Briefly describe your involvement in the LGBTQ community and explain why you feel you should be awarded the Elliot Jackson Jones Memorial Scholarship. This essay should reflect one or more of the following:

1. Your active participation in changing the climate on campus in regards to the LGBTQ community
2. Your commitment to fostering an LGBTQ-friendly atmosphere
3. Your connection to LGBTQ student life here at the University of Alabama

Conclude your essay by explaining how these active engagements will be carried on into your future endeavors.
